Mastering new skills is a challenge Frazier Revitalization supports through our community partnerships.

FINANCIAL BASICS CLASSES: For three Saturdays in November, our third cohort of 2024 will learn about various pathways to improved stability through savings. For those who are able to save \$500, there's even a dollar for dollar match! Participants gain a deeper understanding of insurance, liens, and how to grow generational wealth. New classes will be offered in February, March, May, June, September and October 2025. In-person, hybrid and virtual options will be available. Registration is required.

COMPUTER SKILLS: After an incredibly successful initial class on basic computer skills offered in partnership with The CARDBoard Project, Frazier Revitalization has opened registration for a second class beginning in January 2025. HEALTHY COOKING: A Taste of Hispanic Heritage Cooking Class provided by Prairie View A&M University Cooperative Education Program occurred weekly from August 21 to September 25. Eight homeowners from the Bertrand neighborhood and residents from the Frazier Townhomes participated in each class with 100% class participation each week. Upcoming classes in 2025 will be in February – A Taste

of African Heritage Cooking Class hosted by Prairie View A&M University Cooperative Education Program and in August from Texas A&M University.
